Module TC1: UK healthcare, the GCC & relevant legislation

This online learning module has been produced primarily to help chiropractors prepare for the General Chiropractic Council's Test of Competence (ToC) but may also be helpful for chiropractors wishing to address fitness to practice issues or revise aspects of the GCC Code for CPD purposes. It is the first of a series of modules to be developed in this field.

The module provides an overview of the role and activity of the UK's National Health Service (NHS) and the UK's chiropractic regulator (the General Chiropractic Council; 'GCC'). It goes on to examine the GCC's code of practice ('The Code'), explaining the importance and relevance of related legislation. Each section of the module includes revision questions to enable the candidate to test their progress, and the module concludes with a group of assessed questions for which a pass mark has been set. This enables candidates to measure their level of understanding only – it **does not** provide any credit towards the ToC.



The cost to register on this module is **£49**, which provides access for 12 months. Successful completion enables the candidate to print a certificate of achievement.
