Matt is also currently Lead Chiropractor to EF Education First Professional Cycling Team and travels with them to races all over the world. In 2015 Bloomsbury published Matt's book "The Pain Free Cyclist" about common cycling injuries, which was released in the UK and US, and has since gone on to be translated into German, Dutch and Mandarin.

Nick Metcalfe is a 2008 graduate and a Fellow of the Royal College of Chiropractors Sports Faculty. Currently, he is in this third season as a first-team chiropractor at Fulham FC and runs two multidisciplinary clinics in South-West London. Nick has experience working in a number of sporting environments including the London 2012 Olympics, The Open Gold Championships 2015, Skeleton and Bobsleigh World Championships 2016, and World Athletics Championships 2017. He built up his experience in sport by volunteering for many years before his opportunity in professional football came along. The lessons learned in his first few seasons are still fresh and he's keen to share them to help others in the future.
