This event will cover diagnosis and treatment of vestibular migraine, one of the most common causes of dizziness; it may even be the most common form of dizziness.

Vestibular migraine is under-diagnosed, reduces quality of life and causes a high degree of suffering. Most patients with chronic dizziness will develop neck pain and stiffness. As a result they turn to a chiropractor for help. If the cause of their neck stiffness is missed, the treatment of their neck is likely to fail. We need to treat the migraine AND the neck stiffness to help improve their quality of life and reduce suffering.
