At the age of 40, Sarah slipped into an active phase of alcoholism and chooses to raise awareness of this illness within the healthcare sector. She is in her 9th year of recovery and was able to return to the dental profession after a suspended registration and was deemed 'fit to practice' again in 2017.'
