#### **About the Practice**

This is a small, but well-established and very busy clinic in Wigmore, a pretty part of Gillingham. The practice has been there for over 15 years. For years, there have been two chiropractors working full-time, so with the retirement of one colleague a gap has opened up.

There is an established patient base for a new associate to draw upon once you get started. And, with the retirement of a colleague you can start almost immediately.

There's a friendly atmosphere and attitude and a laid-back approach to help patients feel at ease. The focus is on providing patients with a comprehensive and holistic treatment tailored to their needs, in an evidence-informed, patient-centred way.

The patient demographic ranges across all ages, with a diverse range of issues.

The clinic ownership has recently transferred and with it, an online booking system has been introduced. When you join the clinic as an associate there is the opportunity to influence further changes that may happen in the clinic.

The practice has a focus on Sacro-Occipital Technique combined with Diversified and Activator Technique. It also incorporates extremities, paediatrics and cranial treatments to work in an evidence-informed and patient-centred manner, aiming to optimise individual care.

#### **About the Role**

The position is for a self-employed chiropractor. It is 3 days a week: Monday, Wednesday and every other Friday, and every other Saturday (although if you don't want to work Saturdays, there is the possibility to just work every Friday).

This allows you to work 25-30 hours a week depending on how you choose to utilise the days available, and gives the time and opportunity for a great work-life balance.

For the new graduate, there is mentoring and support available through the PRT programme. The new graduate would be on a split fee of 50% and a higher percentage once they complete their PRT requirements.

The more experienced chiropractor can expect a higher percentage from the start.

### Requirements of the Role

- Good communication skills, with both patients, and colleagues
- Good patient management, diagnostic and treatment skills
- Willingness and interest in learning, growing and developing skills as a chiropractor
- Flexible in attempting to provide patients with a sense of familiarity in treatment style

#### Location

Wigmore is a suburb of Gillingham in Kent with easy access to the M2 either to London or the Coast. There are also quick train links into London, so you can get to central London in less than 1 hour.

Hempstead Valley Shopping Centre is close to the clinic and there is easy access to a High Street, and local business park.

Gillingham is part of Medway, where there is a diverse culture with museums, theatres and events like the Dickens' and Sweeps Festival. The Historic Dockyard of Chatham is one of the main tourist attractions, as is Rochester Castle and the Cathedral. Many locals enjoy walks in local natural areas such as Capstone Park, Darland Banks, Riverside Country Park, and Motney Hill Nature Reserve.
