These can range from the unsettled newborn who cries excessively or has issues around sleeping, feeding, pooping etc., to the baby who dislikes tummy time, crawling and sleeping on their back, to the toddler who has emotional meltdowns triggered by their early signs of developmental delay.

She is also a Pre & Perinatal Educator (PPN Ed) having completed the certification program with APPPAH, the Association of Pre and Perinatal Psychology and Health.
